How to make childcare more affordable at Country Buttercups

Information on our offer of Early Years Education Entitlement, including Universal Entitlement (up to 15 hours), Disadvantaged Two Year funding (up to 15 hours) and Working Parent Entitlement (up to 30 hours)



All funding can only be accessed when attending two or more days a week.

The Universal Offer

All children over 3 years old can access up to 15 free hours a week, term time only, please refer to 'Information for Parents and Carers', copies can be requested and latest version found in entrance lobby.

<u>Disadvantaged Two Year Olds Entitlement</u>

This is an eligibility checked offer, for children aged two years old, who can access up to 15 hours free childcare. You will need to have received a code from Gov.uk for your child to access this funding. Please enquire with East Sussex County Council if you think you may be eligible. We accept these codes subject to availability.

Working Parent Entitlement

The working parent entitlement is an eligibility based offer to access as of the term after your child turns 9 months of age. Up to 30 hours free childcare a week, term time only at Country Buttercups.

This is a fantastic offer that supports those parents who are accessing childcare up to 5 days a week.

You can choose up to 30 hours across your booked sessions at Country Buttercups and the hours can also be shared between us and another setting if this is applicable.

As you may already be aware, we offer short day sessions (8.30-2.30pm) and full day sessions (8.30-16.30) with breakfast club from 8am.

You may use any combination of sessions offered, subject to availability. In preparation for your child's school week, from the age of 3 years, we highly recommend accessing the full entitlement for your child.
